

## 2020 Bowling Rules:

- 1. Bowling will officially start on Friday January 31, 2020
  - a.Bowling will occur every other week with May 8<sup>,</sup> 2020 being the party.
- Only Clients (in good standing) of the Fayette County Association for the Blind will be allowed to bowl.

a. There will be no exceptions.

3. Each client will be allowed to bowl a maximum of 2 games.

a.All games must finish before 2:05 PM

b. No extra time will be allowed.

- 4. The goal is to knock down all ten pins
- 5. Each frame consists of throwing the ball twice to knock down all the pins
- 6. If you knock down all the pins with the first ball, it is called a "strike"
- 7. If you knock down all the pins with the second ball, it is called a "spare"
- 8. Each games consists of ten frames. If you bowl a strike in the tenth frame, you get two more balls. If you throw a spare, you get one more ball.
- 9. Open frames are frames without a strike or spare
- 10. Scoring is based on the number of pins you knock down. However, if you bowl a spare, you get to add the pins in your next ball to that frame. For strikes, you get the next two balls.
- 11. An average of the two games is played. You determine a 2 game average by adding

the 2 scores and then dividing that number by 2.

- 12. Foul line is in effect. If you step over the foul line, any pins knocked down will not count towards your score.
- 13. Ramp Bowling is allowed for those athletes that are not physically capable of rolling a bowling ball. The ramp is for physical disabilities and not to be used to just to increase a score.
- 14. Bumpers are allowed.
- 15. All athletes that need to use the ramp will all bowl in the same lane.

a.No exceptions will be permitted.

- 16. All Athletes may obtain their bowling shoes at counter and must tie their own shoes.
- 17. All Athletes will return their used shoes to the counter. Failure to do this will result in removal of program.

- 18. No food, or drink permitted in bowling area.
- 19. All assistive equipment or animal will remain out of bowling area.
  - a.Wheel chairs will be permitted and the only exception.
- 20. The Fayette County Association for the Blind will pay for the return trip for anyone that arrives by Fact.
- 21. You must attend 5 out of 7 weeks to be eligible for end of year party.
